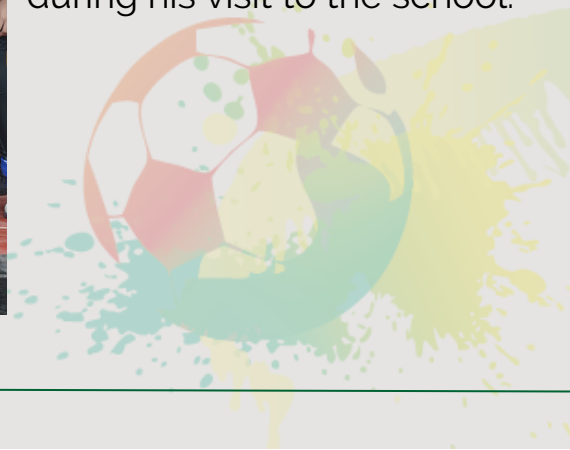
RAJASHREE AT A GLANCE
